


MAKING A FLY TRAP WITH PLASTIC BOTTLES



START WITH TWO PLASTIC BOTTLES. CUT ONE IN HALF.


CUT FLAPS AT THE BOTTOM OF THE OTHER ONE

PUSH THE BOTTLES TOGETHER LIKE THIS

TAKE OFF THE CAP OF THE TOP BOTTLE AND PUT MUD IN.

USE A STICK TO MAKE A HOLE IN THE MUD



ONCE THE MUD HAS DRIED, YOU SHOULD HAVE A SMALL PASSAGE BETWEEN THE TOP AND BOTTOM BOTTLES



NOW HEAP MUD AROUND THE BOTTOM OF THE TRAP. USE STICKS TO POKE HOLES INTO THE FLAPS

YOU CAN POKE BAIT THROUGH THE HOLES

FLIES ENTER THE TRAP AT THE BOTTOM, THEN FLY UP INTO THE TOP.

THEY CAN'T GET OUT, AND THEY DIE.

BAIT WITH FAECES - AND WASH CAREFULLY AFTERWARDS! KEEP BAIT MOIST WITH URINE.
